South Africa also has a few Big Five malaria free national parks, perfect for families with young children.

In the Western Cape, Mediterranean in climate and European in culture, you will find ample opportunities for day cruises, nature hikes, wine tasting, shopping and simply soaking up the spectacular view.

## **BOTSWANA**

The country is an all year round destination. May to August is the dry winter season with moderate days and cold nights. June to August is high water season in the Okavango Delta with opportunities for boating and mokoro excursions. This is the best time for great game viewing. May to October sees increasing numbers of animals concentrated along the Chobe River and central Savute region. September and October is hot and dry with good game viewing. November to April is the rainy summer season. The bush changes into a lush green area and birding is excellent as migrant species arrive in the area. There is also plenty of young antelope around as it is birthing season.

## **MOZAMBIQUE**

April to September offers a sub-tropical climate and is the best time to visit. May to November is winter with cool temperatures and the least chance of rain. December to April is the wet summer season with brief downpours followed by sunshine. January and February is cyclone season in Southern Mozambique. We advise avoiding the Bazaruto Archipelago during this time.

## **NAMIBIA**

The sand dunes of Sossusvlei can be visited at any time of the year however the dry winter climate from March to October is the best time to visit. September and October can get very hot. October to April is summer and the best time for bird watching. May to August is winter and the best time for game viewing in Etosha National Park. June and July can have very cold nights. November and April is the summer rainy season turning the area green and bringing the occasional floods to the desert.

## **SOUTH AFRICA**

The country is an all year round destination. Summer is from October to March and winter from May to August. January to April is the best time to visit Cape Town and enjoy the summer months. October to April is warm and dry. December and February sees the occasional South-Easter wind, blanketing Table Mountain in cloud. July to September is the best time for whale watching and seeing wild flowers in bloom. Kruger National Park is considered an all year destination. May to October is the dry winter season and the best time for game viewing and walking safaris. September and October is dry and hot with animals concentrated around water sources. November to April is rainy season, perfect for photography as everything is lush and green. Game viewing is good, with young animals around and bird watching is great. May to October is the dry winter season and the best time for game viewing in Madikwe Game Reserve. KwaZulu-Natal is a year round destination. May to August is winter with a mild climate, warm ocean and the best time for game viewing.

## **ZAMBIA**

Zambia has a sub-tropical climate defined by a marked wet and dry season rather than summer and winter. The dry season along with mild daytime temperatures runs from May to October and is the best time to go to Zambia for game viewing in the South Luangwa and Lower Zambezi National Park. September and October however can get extremely hot. The rainy season, also known as green season, is from December to April when the bush is beautifully thick and green. This is the best time for bird watching as there are many migrant species in the area. February to May is the best time to visit the Victoria Falls on the Zambian side. The falls are at their fullest from April to May. October and November is dry season with very little water coming over the Zambian side of the falls. The main Falls can still be seen on the Zimbabwe side. White-water rafting is during this time.

## **ZIMBABWE**

February to May is the best time to visit Victoria Falls. April and May the falls are at their fullest. August to December is low water season and the best time to enjoy water rafting as the volume and speed of the water is reduced and the rapids are more exposed. May to August is dry winter season and the best time for game viewing in Mana Pools, Hwange National Park, Lake Kariba and Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve. September and October are extremely hot and dry months.

# Safari in Southern Africa or East Africa?

For many guests a safari is a once in a life time experience and choosing which part of Africa to go to can be a challenge. Here is some useful information to assist in making this tricky decision.

## Southern Africa

### Wildlife

The wildlife in Southern Africa is as varied to that of East Africa, although less dense and found in smaller herds. Game trackers apply their skill in finding the elusive animals and it is a thrilling experience to be a part of the track. With Southern Africa having a large concentration of private game reserves, there is a higher frequency of close up safari experiences that take place when out in the bush.

### Landscapes

Southern Africa has a stunning variety of superbly contrasting landscapes. From the deserts of Namibia with its rolling sand dunes onto the flat floodplains of the Okavango delta to the towering heights of the Drakensburg mountains.

### Activities & Culture

Southern Africa offers a myriad of cultural experiences, along with active adventure, family explorations and wellness journeys. Cosmopolitan cities like Cape Town and Johannesburg offer unusual art experiences, and premium shopping for luxury fashion brands.

### Food & Wine

South Africa in particular is a foodies heaven with a wide range of culinary delights to suit any traveler. There are also a huge number of spectacular vineyard farms along the coast.

### Beaches

The best beaches in Southern Africa are found in Mozambique which can be reached from any of the Southern Africa countries, or hop over to Mauritius.

## East Africa

### Wildlife

The wildlife in East Africa, specifically in Kenya and Tanzania, is found in higher concentrations than elsewhere on the continent; the great wildebeest migration alone contains 2 million individuals. Rwanda and Uganda are also home to the two largest primate species and both these countries can be easily combined with a wildlife safari in Kenya or Tanzania.

### Landscapes

There are a myriad of spectacular landscapes in East Africa - from the soaring mountains of Kilimanjaro and Kenya, the primate rich jungles in Rwanda and Uganda, the many rolling grassland savannahs and the long, wide beaches of the coast.

### Activities & Culture

East Africa has numerous activities available from walking safaris to soaring over the plains in a hot air balloon. There are also a wide variety of cultures for guests to experience from the more famous Masai to the lesser known pygmy Batwa.

### Food & Wine

Not a renowned destination for food but the properties offer delicious meals. There is also the option for guests to have a local cooking class in a village to experience how the locals live.

### Beaches

Both Kenya and Tanzania have glorious beaches with powder-white sandy beaches just a short flight away from the national parks and reserves.

### FRIDAY SHABBAT MEAL

Our Jewish Hop On Guide, Ivor, alongside his wife, enjoys hosting Jewish guests at their home for a Friday night Shabbat dinner. On arrival enjoy a welcome drink ranging from fruit juice to a whiskey and a bit of “getting to know you” conversation. Traditional blessings over wine ( kiddush) and bread (challah) will be performed together with blessings for the guests. Dinner is served in the dining room, consisting of

a starter, followed by a main course of either fish, meat or vegetarian with accompanying vegetables and salads, ending with a fruit platter and apple or plum pie.

Thereafter if preferred, there would be grace after meals (full or shortened versions) followed by tea or coffee in the lounge. The home and all food served, whether bought or home prepared, would be Kosher.

### JEWISH CULTURAL TOUR OF CAPE TOWN

Experience the history of the Jewish Community's roots in Cape Town's city centre as well as witnessing the growth of a healthy and vibrant community.

The South African Jewish Museum, opened by Nelson Mandela in 2000 is situated on the heritage site of the Gardens Synagogue built in 1863. It also houses the Cape Town Holocaust Centre and the Gitlin Library. The Cape Town Holocaust Centre, the first in Africa, explores racial and religious intolerance, ideological conflict and persecution, echoing the human rights abuses of the apartheid era in South Africa. We will also visit the Great Synagogue.

Depending on the timing of the day, we could also walk through the Company Gardens. The gardens offer a fresh produce garden for visiting ships from the mid-17th Century. It is also home to the Houses of Parliament as well as Cape Town's Jewish Campus and you can discover a little-known artefact in the South African National Gallery.
