ITINERARY

1 Arrive in Johannesburg

Arrive at Johannesburg International Airport, transfer to your hotel and overnight. The transfer time is approximately 50 minutes.

Johannesburg is the gateway to Southern Africa and offers first world infrastructure, hotels and a variety of world-class restaurants. Today, Johannesburg is one of the South Africa's largest city and the world's youngest major cities. Soweto is an increasingly popular destination for travellers from around the world. The Apartheid Museum is a worthwhile stop for any traveller wanting to learn more about South Africa's previous regime. Enjoy the buildings of the gold rush era and the sights from a top the Carlton Centre (Africa's tallest building). The Market Theatre precinct, Museum of Africa and Newtown (New Town) , Sterkfontein Caves, Hector Peterson Memorial, Cradle of Humankind, and the Nelson Mandela Bridge are particularly vibrant sectors of the city centre. By day, a walk around Newtown will give you a taste for the wide range of traditions and cultures the city plays host to.

2 Fly to Greater Kruger National Park

Meet your guide in the reception area of your hotel for your transfer to the Federal Air Hangar. The transfer time is approximately 50 minutes. Depart by shared light aircraft flight to the camp airstrip, where you will be met and transferred to the camp/ lodge and overnight. The flying time is approximately one hour.

5 Fly To Cape Winelands

After breakfast, transfer to the camp/ lodge airstrip for your private light aircraft flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. The flying time is approximately 20 minutes. Fly to Cape Town International Airport on a scheduled flight. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the Winelands and overnight. The transfer time is approximately one hour and 15 minutes.

Forty kilometres to the east of Cape Town, lies generous valleys known as the Cape Winelands. This area is a collection of historic towns, little hamlets and Cape Dutch farmsteads that produce and provide some of the best wines to the world. The mountains create an incredible scenic backdrop for a myriad vines, and also make this area the best environment for wine making. The Cape Winelands include Drakenstein, Somerset West, Stellenbosch, Witzenberg and Breede River Valley, and Langeberg winelands. Collectively they are known as the 'pearls' of South Africa's rural and small towns.
