### **Turtle Safari**

### White Pearl Resorts

White Pearl Resorts is home to one of the richest turtle nesting sites in southern Mozambique. The nesting season is between November and February each year, and guests have the opportunity to witness an extraordinary feat of nature first-hand. Loggerhead and Leatherback Turtles head to this stretch of coast to lay eggs, a few weeks later, the hatchlings make their first-ever voyage to the ocean. Watching a turtle hatch an egg is a beautiful experience.





### **Ocean Safari**

#### White Pearl Resorts

Venture by boat to the nearby pinnacle reef for a snorkelling trip, and you get a chance to swim with the bottlenose Dolphins that regularly glide through these waters. From July to November each year, you may encounter the majestic humpback whales in their natural habitat as they visit on their annual migration. Whale watching is from the comfort of the snorkelling boat. Observe these magnificent creatures blowing, breaching, lob tailing and playing.



### **Sunset Dhow Cruise**

#### Benguerra Island

Set off on a sunset cruise around the bay in a dhow, a traditional wooden sailing vessel with a triangular sail. This is used by the island's locals and gives you a unique window on the everyday world of the island's fishermen. Breathe in the fresh breeze of the ocean, and toast the end of an exciting day as you watch the setting sun on the horizon.




### Benguerra Island

## **Ocean Exploration**

#### Santorini

The waters here are an ecological paradise. This is one of the largest marine conservation areas in the Indian Ocean. Discover reefs teeming with life, including dolphin, humpback whales, whale sharks, sharks, manta and spotted eagle rays, game fish, green turtles and giant lobsters. The endangered dugong of which only a very small number still exist, swim in the shallow crystal clear waters that are also home to starfish, soft and hard corals, anemones, seahorses and an array of beautiful tropical fish.
