## Discover Tour of Mahé

Experience the diversity and scenic beauty of Mahé Seychelles. Begin the tour at the capital, Victoria and the picturesque charms of its ancient clock tower and colourful market. Travel on the Jardin du Roi and end the day off in the traditional ambiance of the Craft Village. Available Monday, Wednesday and Friday.





## Cousin, Curieuse & St Pierre Islands

A day out on the ocean with a boat. Cruise past the picturesque Praslin coastline to arrive at the island of Cousin, this is a nature reserve home to some of the rarest birds. Then go to Curieuse island National Marine Park where a unique eco-system awaits as you. Have a delicious barbecue lunch on the soft sand beach surrounded by giant tortoises. Finish the tiny islet of Pierre where you can snorkel into a kaleidoscope of underwater activity and crystal water. Available Tuesday and Thursday.





## Boat & Bike La Digue Tour

This tour is ideal for the more adventurous, who seek to explore La Digue Island on their own. The ferry crossing to La Digue is at 09h00 and on arrival you will be given a short briefing on the most popular sites, best routes and lunch venues, before receiving a map and bicycle, for a day of exploring. The boat back to Praslin departs at 16:30. Available daily.



## Reef Safari

Take a short boat ride from the capital, Victoria, where you will see the underwater ecosystem of Sainte Anne Marine park. Motor out onto the marine park where you will board the semi-submersible to keep your feet dry while exploring the teeming reefs. Feed the fish breakfast before exploring your own submarine adventure. Have a mouth-watering buffet made in traditional Seychellois style with traditional Creole rhythms, and then enjoy a relaxing swim for the rest of the afternoon.

Available Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Sunday.



## Vallee de Mai & Anse Lazio

Discover the Vallee de Mai where the famous Coco De Mer that grows on ancient palms was discovered. You will visit one of the island's most magnificent beaches, Anse Lazio where magnificent boulders grace silver sands lapped by clear turquoise waters. Available Monday, Thursday and Friday.



## Praslin & La Digue Tour

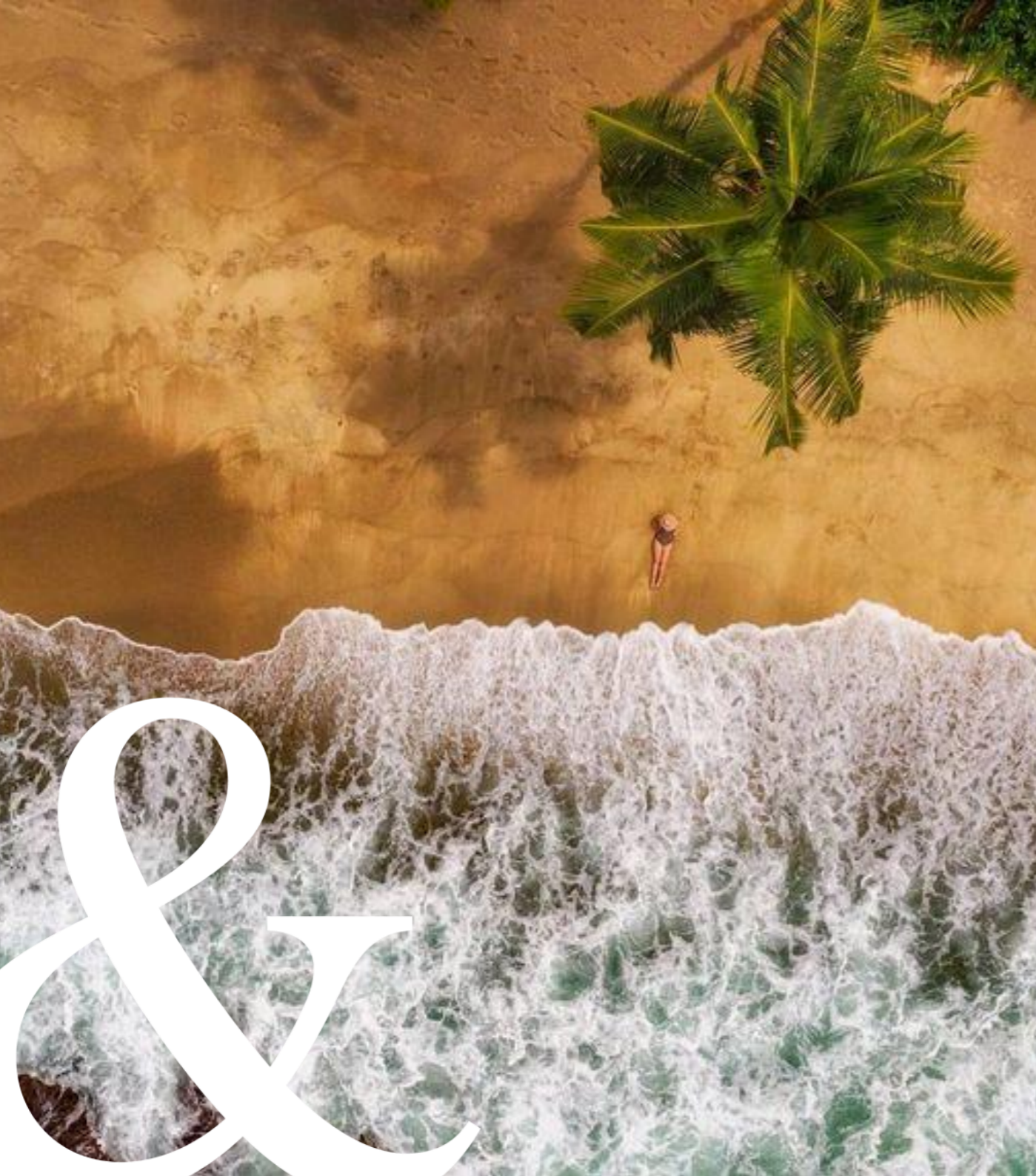
Experience the unique and breathe taking natural beauty of these two islands. La Digue is still steeped in the tranquil atmosphere of the island by ox cart admiring the picturesque harbour. Visit the neighbour island Praslin and see the famous Coco de Mer which grows in the towering palms. Enjoy a magnificent Creole buffet on Praslin for lunch which the famous coconut milk and fresh fruits. Available Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.



## Vallee de Mai Tour

Enter the forgotten world of Praslin which has still been untouched by man, where the famous Coco De Mer was first discovered. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is believed to be the original site of the Garden of Eden. It nurtures several rare species of flora and fauna for you to enjoy. Available Monday, Thursday and Friday.





## Peaks of Paradise

Explore the untouched splendour of Mahé's north coast and discover one of Seychelles best loved hiking trails as you enjoy a guided hike through the Morne Seychelles National Park. An easy-going 1 hour 30 minute hike over rocky coastal peaks and tropical forests will lead to Anse Major – a secluded beach only accessible via boat or this mountain path. A catamaran will be waiting to receive guests, who may opt to spend the afternoon at leisure swimming, snorkelling or sunbathing in this stunning bay. Valid only during the south east tradewinds in the months of April to October.
