## Sunset Turtle Tracks

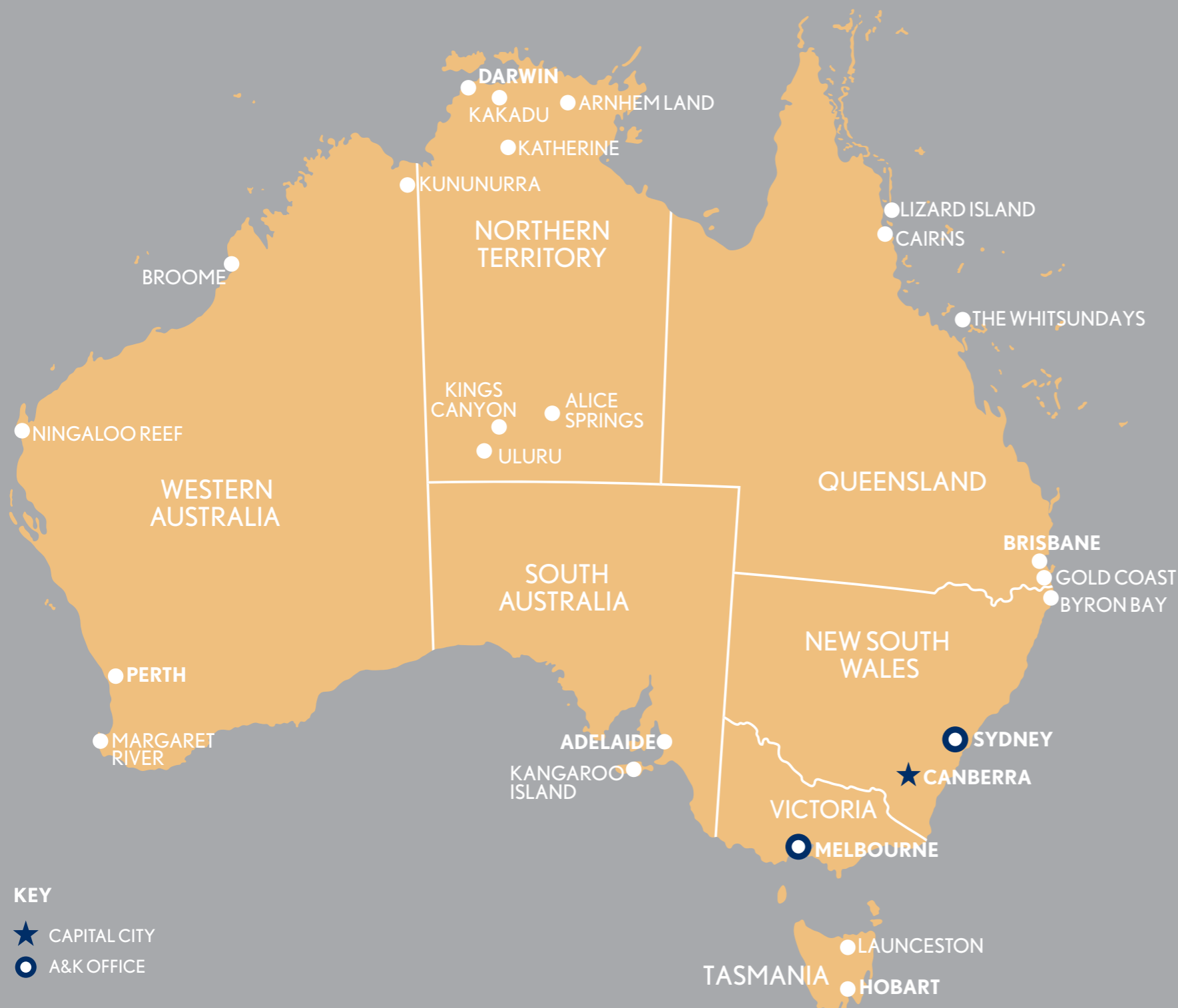

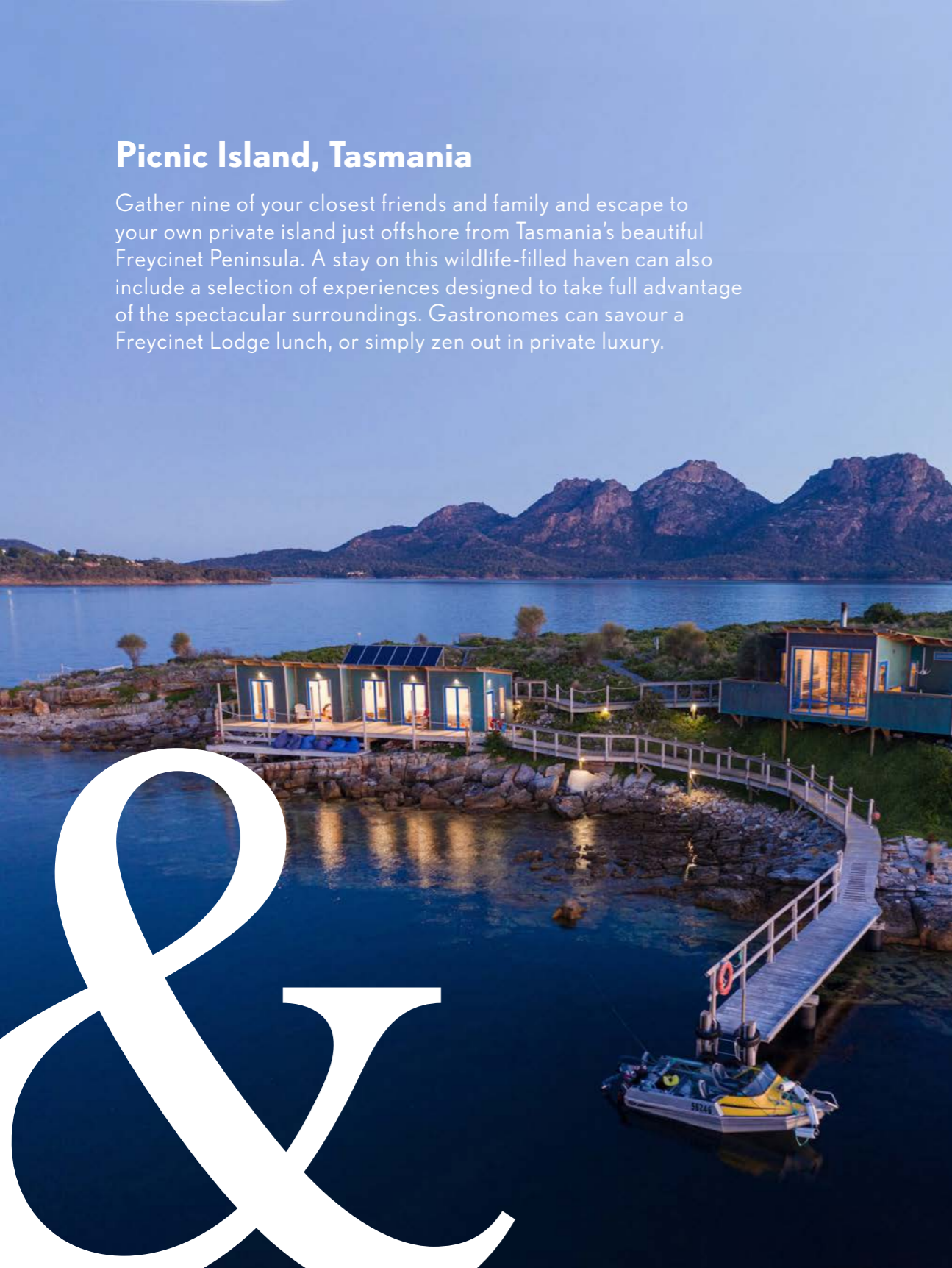


## **Swim with Whale Sharks at Ningaloo Reef**

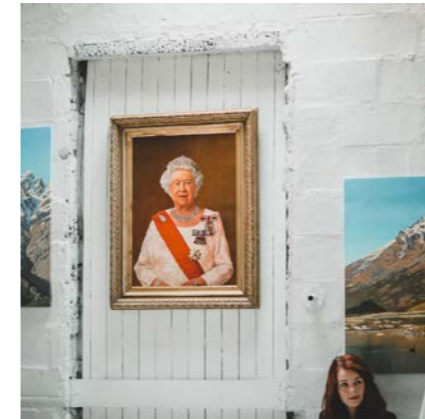

## MARGARET BARKER'S GARDEN

### Private Garden Tour of Larnach Castle, Dunedin

Explore New Zealand's only castle, Larnach Castle, built in 1871 by William Larnach. The Barker family purchased the castle in 1967 and spent decades restoring it, decorating it with original period furniture and antiques. Enjoy a private presentation and tour of Margaret Barker's gardens by a garden expert as you learn about Margaret's inspiration. Margaret Barker may guide this tour.



## ULVA GOODWILLIE

### World's Southernmost Conservation Program at Ulva Island, Endorsed by Prince Harry

Ulva Island is a bird sanctuary located at New Zealand's southernmost tip. Tours are conducted by the passionate and knowledgeable Ulva Goodwillie. Named after her island home, Ulva is a direct descendant of the first Maori peoples of Stewart Island. On this tour, you'll learn about the native flora and fauna from a Maori and local Stewart Island perspective.
