DAY 7 Discover one of Spain's holiest shrines and the legendary fortress of Pelayo at Covadonga, from where Christian armies began the Reconquista DAY 8 Admire the elegant city life of Oviedo, the capital of the Asturias region, including the

magnificent cathedral DAY 9 Witness the splendid mansions of Gijon where impoverished emigrants returned to after making their fortunes in the Americas

DAY 10 Take in the enchanting fishing village of Cudillero, before exploring the Roman city walls of Lugo DAY 11 Behold the wonders of Santiago de Compostela, a leading Christian pilgrimage site and supposed resting place of St James at the awe-inspiring eponymous cathedral

DAY 12 Traverse the beautiful fjord-like coastline of Galicia and see the locals fish for barnacles whilst suspended from clifftops




Suggested Itinerary Art, Architecture and Mountain Beauty
