A wonderfully diverse destination that never disappoints, visitors flock to marvel at Italy's rich cultural heritage and wealth of natural treasures and to enjoy the pleasures of *la dolce vita*.

NORTHERN ITALY

Venice is like no other place in the world with an air of pure romantic charm. Built entirely on water, this extraordinary floating city showcases a stunning mix of Byzantine, Gothic and Renaissance architecture. The pretty islands of Murano, Torcello and Burano, famous for their lace and glass workshops, lie within a pleasant cruise from the city.

Liguria, or 'The Italian Riviera', has northern Italy's most attractive stretch of coastline, including the glamorous marina of Portofino and tiny but beautiful villages of the Cinque Terre, famous for the picturesque hiking paths that run between them.

Milan is Italy's most dynamic city, serving as the capital of fashion and design. Milan comes to life with designer boutiques, restaurants, museums and cultural experiences of the highest level and is also home to da Vinci's 'Last Supper', located at the 15th century Santa Maria delle Grazie.

In the Italian Lake District, the lakes of Como, Garda and Maggiore offer the visitor a haven of palatial villas, rose-laden belvederes, hanging wisteria and majestic Alpine vistas, while the

soaring Dolomites dominate the north.

CENTRAL ITALY

Rome is a heady blend of artistic and architectural masterpieces, classical ruins and extravagant baroque churches and piazze. A veritable living museum, you can see and touch the city's 2,700 years of history which are on display everywhere you look.

Umbria is an ancient region blessed with steep hills, deep valleys and fast-flowing rivers. The relatively untouched countryside and architecturally rich towns of Perugia, Assisi and Orvieto are well worth exploring.

Tuscany, with its beautiful landscape and fascinating towns, is surely the best known region of central Italy. Local festivals and pageants, such as the Palio in Siena, are held with ancient pomp and ceremony whilst towns such as San Gimignano and Lucca hold an abundance of archaic charm. A monument to the Renaissance, visitors to Florence cannot fail to delight in the architectural masterpieces, art galleries and artisan boutiques.

SOUTHERN ITALY

The Amalfi Coast, from Sorrento to Salerno, takes travellers past rocky cliffs plunging into the sea and sandy coves dotted with coloured boats. Amalfi, Ravello and Positano cling precariously to steep cliff sides whilst the islands of sophisticated Capri and its

peaceful neighbour, Ischia, beckon. A short drive away, the ancient sites of Pompeii and Herculaneum reveal towns frozen in time since their burial in AD79 under the molten lava of Mount Vesuvius.

The island of Sicily, possesses an old-world charm not found on the mainland, whilst historical influences from across the Mediterranean are evident in the temples of Agrigento, Syracuse and the Greek Theatre at Taormina. For gastronomes, Sicily offers the pinnacle of excellent local fish and wines.

Puglia is less well known but similarly charming, occupying the quiet 'heel' of Italy and resembling Greece with its whitewashed houses and stunning beaches.

"The only thing more striking than St Marks Basilica is the snake of people lining up to go inside it. Our guide walked us right past the line to an innocuous looking side door, a quick "ciao" from our guide to the security man and we were straight in!"

CROATIA, SLOVENIA & MONTENEGRO



CROATIA

Zagreb, Croatia's capital, is a cosmopolitan city awash with cultural institutions and theatres. Important museums include the Ethnographical Museum, Mimara Museum, the Gallery of Old Masters and the Gallery of Modern Art.

Istria is a beautiful region with fascinating towns, a beautiful coastline and three National Parks. Porec's Venetian heritage is evident in its palaces, squares and religious buildings whilst Pula is known for its Roman monuments, notably the ancient Roman Amphitheatre and the Gate of Hercules. The Venetian city of Rovinj is a true delight and the truffle and vineyard region around Motovun is truly stunning. The UNESCO World Heritage Site of Plitvice National Park is also famous for its spectacular waterfalls, enticing lakes and rich flora and fauna.

Split's Roman city centre is full of charm; principal sights include the Emperor Diocletian's Palace, once a vast home for the emperor, the Renaissance Town Hall on People's Square and the Museum of Split with its 16th century works, paintings and books.

Dubrovnik was dubbed "the pearl of the Adriatic" by Lord Byron and is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site not to be missed. Be sure to visit the 14th century Sponza Palace which houses the State Archives, the Dominican Monastery, the Rector's

Palace and the Square of the Loggia.

The Dalmatian Coast Islands, just a short boat ride from Dubrovnik or Split, boast great beaches, fields of scented lavender and plump olives, as well as authentic, little known but excellent, wines. The island of Hvar, a fashionable Mediterranean resort, is known for its wealth of wild flowers, whilst Korcula is home to a fascinating collection of Venetian and Dalmatian art and Byzantine icons. Croatia's most spectacular beach can be found on the beautiful and tranquil island of Brac.

SLOVENIA

Ljubljana is the relaxed and friendly capital of Slovenia, characterised by its beautiful Baroque architecture juxtaposed with the younger Art Nouveau designs. More recently, world-famous architect Jože Plecnik has made a notable mark on the city. The Three Bridges provide an elegant entrance into the Old Town which buzzes with restaurants, cafés, galleries and antique shops. A climb up the tower of Ljubljana Castle will be rewarded with stunning panoramic views of the city.

Bled is a must see spot for any visitor to Slovenia. Perched on a rock above the town lies Bled Castle, from which you are offered enchanting picture postcard views of the town and the Assumption of Mary Pilgrimage Church, famously positioned on a small island in the pristine glacial lake. In the town,

be sure to try some Kremšnita, Slovenia's famous custard cream cake.

Postojna is home to the second largest cavern in Europe. This awe-inspiring 12-mile cave system has been continuously shaped and enlarged over millions of years into spacious chambers and intriguing passages sculpted by a myriad of stalactites and stalagmites. This phenomenal grotto can be explored aboard a special train.

MONTENEGRO

Kotor's magnificent medieval architecture and famous monuments have resulted in a UNESCO world heritage listing and the Cathedral of St Tryphon reflects a remarkable legacy of Roman culture. The striking city lies in an amazing fjord, rivalling those of Norway.

Budva dates back to the 5th century BC. Charmingly picturesque, the town sits upon a small peninsula, a treasure house of cultural heritage. With numerous beautiful sandy beaches and the exclusive resort of Sveti Stefan just a short excursion away, this is the perfect spot for a relaxing retreat.
