

Our favourite adventure experiences

Shark cage diving, Cape Town

Between Dyer Island and Geyser Rock, is the aptly named "Shark Alley", arguably the best place for encounters with Great White Sharks. In the company of experienced experts and researchers, the boat anchors for about two hours depending on shark activity, weather conditions and number of divers.

Huey Flight, Cape Town

Choose between two options: The Atlantico (20 min): Enjoy the unsurpassed beauty of the Cape Coast with views of the city and Table Mountain. The Peninsula (60 min): Experience the entire Cape Peninsula, from breath-taking mountains, endless beaches, wine estates, down to Cape Point Nature Reserve.

Tsitsikamma Canopy Tours, Western Cape

Walk 90 feet (30 Metres) off the ground in the canopy of the Tsitsikamma rainforest where many of the giant Yellowwood trees are 70 years old. The birdlife and scenery is spectacular while professional guides ensure guests don't miss anything in the forest.





Walking with elephants

What better guide to the African bush than a fully-grown African elephant? Jabu, Thembi and Morula 'take' guests on walks through the bush while foraging along the way. The morning ends with guests enjoying a bush brunch in their company.

Chimpanzee Trekking, Uganda & Tanzania

One of our closest living relatives, it is absolutely fascinating to observe chimpanzees in their natural habitat. Trekking can be done in several locations in Uganda - our preferred being Kibale National Park and in Tanzania the rarely visited Mahale Mountains.

Riding safari, Laikipia & Masai Mara, Kenya

On horseback humans become just another animal in the bush. This allows quests to get a little closer to the game and capture some amazing photographs. Kenya and Tanzania offers the perfect plains to explore on horseback. Rides in Laikipia can be adjusted to suit the guests' level of expertise.

Gorilla Trekking, Bwindi NP, Uganda

One of the most incredible experiences for any adventurer. The hike will take guests through untouched rainforest along with encounters of monkeys, birds and other creatures. Guests are able to spend an hour with the gorilla family.

Masai Walking Trails, Loita Hills, Masailand

Explore the sacred Loita Hills on foot with the best possible guides, the local Masai. These hills rise 2000metres (6500 feet) above the Masai Plains and offer some of the best possible views anywhere

Our favourite "hidden secrets"

Meru National Park, Kenya

Meru and Kora sister parks feature jungles, rivers, swamps, grasslands and termite cathedrals. Rarely visited and unspoilt, few places compare to its remote atmosphere. Visitors can see lion, cheetah, Grevy's zebras, elephants, Bohor reedbucks, hartebeests, buffalos and over 427 species of birds.

Ruaha National Park, Tanzania

Tanzania's largest national park is named after the Great Ruaha River. Home to four of the Big Five, Ruaha also hosts more than 570 different bird species and offers some of Southern Tanzania's most compelling views.

Mahale Mountains, Tanzania

Located on the edge of Lake Tanganyika, these mountains rising up from the shoreline are home to some of the habituated chimps of Tanzania. The forest reaches the shoreline on a white sandy beach where guests can enjoy a range of activities including kayaking and fishing.





Kidepo Valley National Park, Uganda

Kidepo, Uganda's most isolated park, lies on the border of Uganda – and offers one of the most beautiful savannah landscapes fringed by distant mountain ranges. A wide range of mammals call this home including the striped hyaena, aardwolf, caracal, kudu and Chandler's mountain reedbuck.

Garden Route, Eastern & Western Cape

The scenic Garden Route is considered by many to be South Africa's "Garden of Eden". Explore miles of sweeping, unspoilt beaches, dramatic peninsulas, lagoons, estuaries, towering forests, rivers and sea. Popular spots include Knysna, Wilderness, Plettenberg Bay and the Tsitsikamma National Park.

Grootbos Private Nature Reserve, Western Cape

Located where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet, the reserve is only two hours from Cape Town and home to one of the richest and biologically diverse marine ecosystems including the Marine

Phinda Private Game Reserve, Kwazulu

The reserve is set within easy reach of the Indian Ocean coastline and the famous iSimangaliso / Greater St Lucia Wetland Park in Northern KwaZulu-Natal. Phinda is known for its abundant wildlife, diversity of habitats and wide range of safari activities.

Benguerra Island, Mozambique

Characterised by sand dunes, inland lakes and idyllic beaches, Benguerra is home to over 140 bird species and the pristine waters are host to one of the most pristine coral reefs in the world. Enjoy a series of adventures such as dhow cruises, diving and snorkelling.

A&K Philanthropy (AKP)

Abercrombie & Kent Philanthropy (AKP) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preserving natural habitats, protecting wildlife and promoting the welfare of indigenous communities throughout the world. Working through Abercrombie & Kent's 50 global offices, AKP supports and coordinates these activities on behalf of A&K.









AKP Projects in Southern and East Africa

A&K Southern Africa's AKP pprojects include the Peninsula School Feeding Association in Cape Town, where we sponsor 200 children to be fed every school day of the year. At Nakatindi Village and School situated in Livingstone our projects include new boreholes for clean water, and expanding the school's vegetable garden to stream income and supplement the children's diet. We built a new classroom block and established a school feeding programme with guest support, and built a rural health clinic. We are working to establish a village bike shop and bike tour enterprise, and will also supply each graduating student enrolled at the high school 10 km away with bike. In Botswana A&K along with a few partners have relocated 20 rhinos from South Africa to the Moremi Game Reserve where they will thrive under protection against poachers.

A&K East Africa's AKP projects include the Ilboru Primary School, a special needs programme that educates hearing impaired children and others with mental and physical disabilities. AKP constructed the first primary school classroom for deaf and disabled children in the Arusha Region and is moving forward to establish the first secondary school classrooms for these students. Bwindi Community Hospital (BCH) provides health care to impoverished communities living in the area. AKP is sponsoring Nursing School Scholarships for students at the BCH Nursing School. Built with the support of our guests, the nursing school will provide a new generation of nurses to work in rural clinics. In 2017, it was rated the number one nursing school in Uganda. BEST TIME TO VISIT

Botswana

The country is an all year round destination. May to October is dry season when game viewing is at its best. November to April the landscape changes to lush greens with plenty of young running around.

Kenya

June to October and December to March offers the best game viewing. The migration is generally in the Masai Mara from late June to September.

Mozambique

With its sub-tropical climate, April to September is the best time to visit. Summer is from December to March which is also the rainy season.

Namibia

March to October is the best time to visit. Summer is from October to April which is also the rainy season.

South Africa

The country is an all year round travel destination.

Summer is from October to March and winter from May to August.

Tanzani

June to October and December to March is the best time for game viewing. The migration is generally in the Northern Serengeti from October to December, in the Southern Serengeti from February to April and in the Grumeti from June to July.

Uganda

The country is an all year round travel destination.

The rainy season is from September to November and March to May.

Zambia

May to October is the dry season and offers the best game viewing. November to April is the rainy season. Victoria Falls flows at its fullest from April to May.

Zimbabwe

Zimbabwe is an all year round travel destination. Summer is from October to April which is also the rainy season and winter from May to September. Victoria Falls flows at its fullest from April to May.
