- On the other side of the city, true car enthusiasts can see how V8 engines are made by hand and finished vehicles are tested at the Affalterbach factory




Porsche and Volkswagen Germany

- Alternatively you can behold the spectacular 360° panorama of the entire Porsche grounds from the top of the diamond-shaped Customer Centre



- Warm up a Ferrari 458, F12 or F430 Challenge on the streets of Maranello as you head towards the Autodromo di Modena – here you leave the traffic behind and unleash the power of your car over several laps of the course

- The finest luxury Italian cars can be driven on race courses that are only a short distance from the country's major destinations: Milan (circuits at Monza or Cremona), Venice (Adria), the Lakes region (Franciacorta), Bologna (Imola), Florence (Mugello) and Rome (Vallelunga)



Ferrari, Lamborghini and Maserati Italy



Track visits and test drives can be combined with behind-the-scenes tours of factories across the region, from the Alfa Romeo Museum in the north to the Ducati Museum in the south



The cluster of top-range manufacturers allows you to combine experiences together. Within a 30-mile stretch between Modena and Bologna you can find the showrooms, factories and museums of Lamborghini, Maserati, Pagani and Ducati – test drives and private tours of several can be enjoyed in the space of just one day

Ferrari and Porsche Spain

- The Fast Parcmotor Castelloli near Barcelona offers a number of high-adrenalin driving experiences on a variety of circuits
- Zoom round the challenging corners and elevation changes of this Gran Turismo track on a Ferrari California or Porsche 911



Ferrari and Porsche Spain



- The Parcmotor is a particularly good venue for larger groups of motor enthusiasts
- The karting course allows a sizeable number of racers to compete against each other, with full qualifying and a race over the 1.3km circuit

Vintage and Classic Cars

- Sightseeing in some classic destinations is enhanced with a simple change in vehicle – get a taste of the French Riviera that is even more luxury than usual in a chauffeur-driven Rolls Royce

- Zoom across the coast of the Riviera in a high-speed cigarette boat ride
